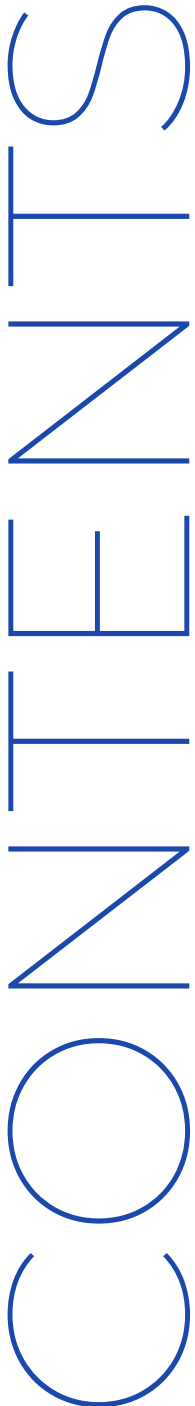

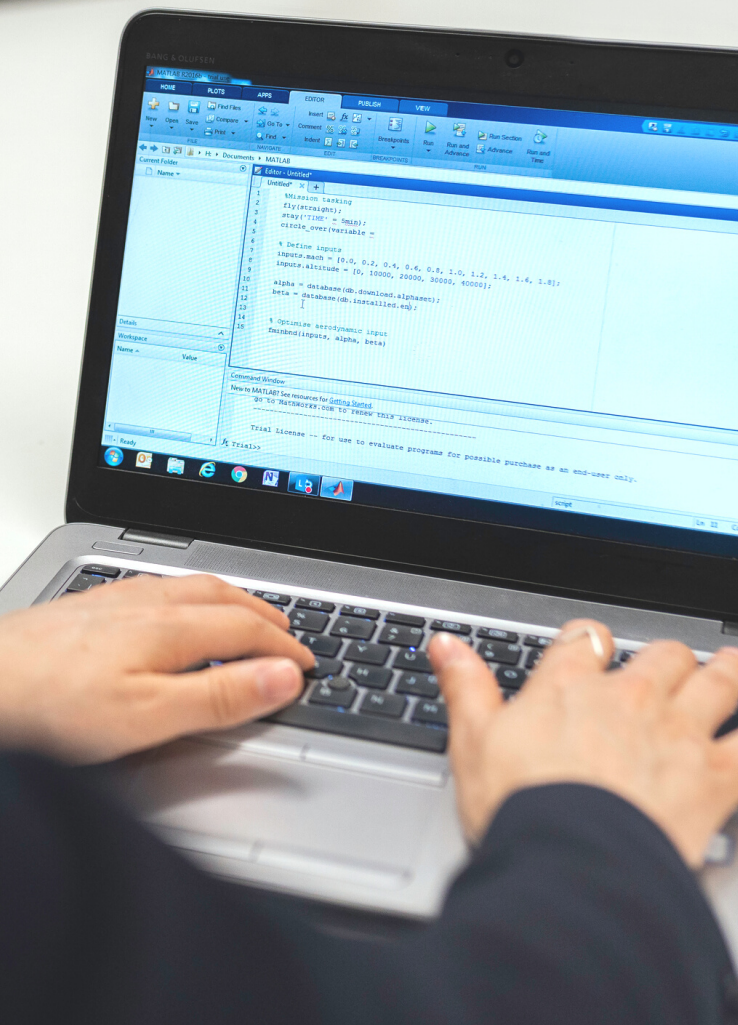

### SUPPORTING VULNERABLE COMMUNITIES

**We have worked with vulnerable communities for over 12 years, improving the quality of life of children and families in these areas.**

**Comprehensively, we focus on areas such as education, health, wellbeing, nutrition, entrepreneurship, spiritual growth, and others.**

**Currently our three community centers include: Quito (where we serve 300 children from 180 families), Guayaquil (100 children from 50 families) and Salcedo (80 children in 40 different families).**

# HEALTH CLINICS



## MEDICAL ATTENTION

**Our objective is to bring medical care into vulnerable communities where appropriate medical attention is not easy to access. These communities often do not have the abilities to administer medicine or run lab tests, which result in infant malnutrition and an increase in chronic illnesses.**

**Since 2021, we have served more than 1000 people, who otherwise struggle to have access to care in the specialized areas of pediatrics, ophthalmology, dentistry, and psychology.**

**We also actively fight against malnutrition and are working to create awareness around the importance of healthcare.**

## PROVIDING MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES

**It is a reality that mental illness makes personal progress very challenging.**

**The greatest need for many of the families with which we work is psychological attention.**

**In the clinic for psychology, we treat problems including depression, addiction, suicide, and domestic violence.**

**Since 2022, we have held a support group for patients, where we help them continue to fight and overcome their psychological battles.**

# MALNUTRITION



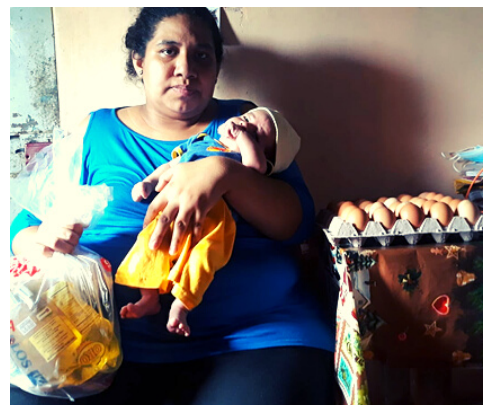
## PROVIDING FOOD IN EXTREME SITUATIONS
